UL – UL stands for upper-level junior/senior courses (300- or 400- level) & denotes the minimum upper-level credit that must be taken at UMGC for graduation

Courses placed in the ELECTIVES/MINOR section may meet degree requirements depending on which course the student takes from the list of courses offered for the associate's degree. Any credit applied to the associate degree must also meet UMGC's transfer credit policy

+ The following courses must be completed either prior to enrolling at UMGC or completed the first semester at UMGC: PSYC 100, SOCY 100, BIOL 201, BIOL 202, BIOL 230, any computer course, and STAT 200. No substitutions can be made in the GER block for these required courses.

The BSN is available only to students with an associate degree in nursing and unencumbered RN licensure.

Per the MD RN to BSN articulation model, nursing credits will not be transferred. Students are instead awarded 30 upper-level credits from their active, unencumbered RN license after passing the NCLEX.

Students must have a conferred associate degree in Nursing from a community college on UMGC's approved list of institutions to accept transfer credit. Students are required to have an active unencumbered RN license from AR, AZ, CO, CT, DC, DE, FL, GA, HI, IL, IN, KS, KY, MD, ME, MI, MS, MT, NC, ND, NH, NJ, NM, NV, NY, OH, OK, OR, PA, RI, SC, SD, TX, VA, VT, WI, or WV only.
