Equity and Inclusion: Raquel Brooks stated that the council would be meeting on April 21st. HR 4005, *Access for Employees with Disabilities*, and GA 3060 *ADA Grievance* need minor updates, including to employee titles.

Instructional & Student Affairs Council: Stephanie McCaslin and Kelly Winters gave updates, including a recommendation that HR 4065, *Flexible Work Schedules* and HR 4155 *Telework* be merged. The council also reviewed GA 3005 *College Committees* and found that many of the listed committees had been disbanded.

Talent Development: Laura Dyson and Jesse Gonzalez gave updates on HR 4100, *Leave* and *Transitional Sabbaticals*. Both would benefit from a review by Human Resources and need edits for grammar and style. Jesse Gonzalez stated that *Transitional Sabbaticals* especially needed revision for grammar. Regarding *Transitional Sabbaticals*, the council recommends that Faculty Senate and Financial Services both review the policy. Also, they asked whether replacements can be hired during the sabbatical, and suggested clarification was needed for the letter of recommendation.
