Are you interested in coastal wildlife? Like shore birds, dolphins, whales, and horseshoe crabs? Then this trip is for you! Travel with fellow students and your instructor. Take a ferry ride from Lewes, DE to Cape May, NJ where you will stay at the Cape May Point Science Center for three days and two nights. Activities will include a boating trip to observe shore birds, dolphins, and whales; nature walks; and lectures from local experts on species such as the Horseshoe Crab and the Red Knott Birds.

Registration is now open and is limited to the first 15 students.
