## Talking Points

CSM is the **sixth largest community college** in Maryland.

**Students save, on average, more than \$31,000** on their bachelor's degree by starting at CSM and transferring with an associate degree.

**63%** of CSM students attend part time.

**94%** of CSM's full-time faculty hold a master's or doctoral degree.

In FY24, CSM awarded **753 associate degrees and 555 certificates.**



CSM offers **300+** transfer agreements with **70+** partnering four-year institutions, including the University of Maryland, Towson, Salisbury, Virginia Commonwealth, George Mason, UMBC, University of Maryland School of Nursing, and more.

More than **1,600 high school students participated in dual enrollment** in the 2023-24 academic year, with more than 170 enrolled in CSM's Early College program.

In the past five years, the CSM Foundation has awarded **\$4.6 million in scholarships** to more than 4,000 students.

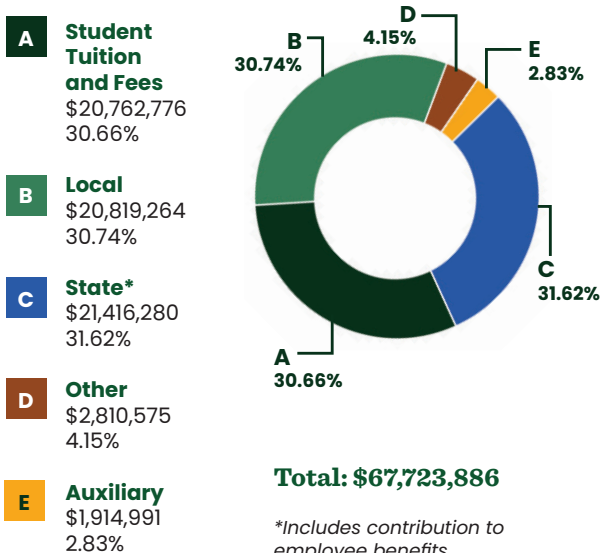

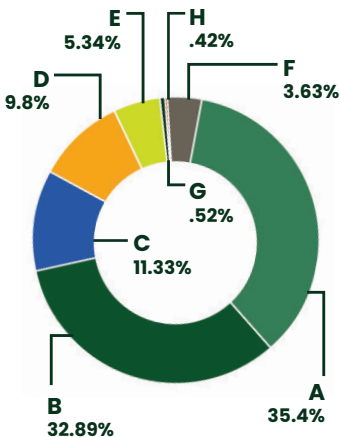

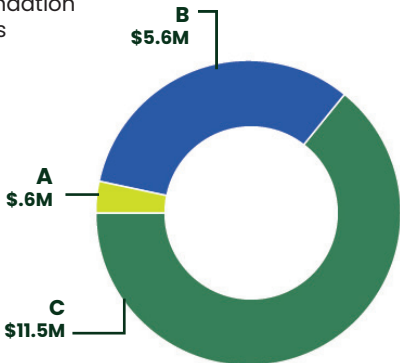
