Get Your Full Housing Allowance—Register for Summer Classes!

If you receive a Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA) as part of your military education benefits, you can **maximize the benefit payment** by registering for summer classes.

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) only pays MHA for months when you are actively taking classes, which means that you won't receive MHA if you aren't taking classes between the Spring and Fall Semesters.
